Test scores: If you plan to apply and are taking the SAT I or ACT this spring or fall, you must enter **Code 2175** on your test application to ensure that your test scores are sent directly to the Flinn Scholars Program.

Qualifications: Flinn Scholars rank in the top 5% of the graduating class, attain a minimum 3.5 grade point average, score a minimum combined total of 1280 on the SAT 1 (critical reading and math sections only) or 29 on the ACT, and participate and demonstrate leadership in a variety of extracurricular activities.
